Urban Green Graduation Programme

In this month as per plan CUP has mainly two programmes under the Green Graduation Programme but several activities and lobbying with the relevant authorities for performing the programme and also works with the consultant team for preparation of drafting the report of strategic plan and relevant activities.

Programme: 4.2.1 Meeting with urban primary health care service delivery authorities (PD, UPHCSDP under ministry of Local Government)

Activity: National Level Consultation on “Challenges and Opportunities of Urban Primary Health Care Services”

As per advice of PD (Project Director, UPHCSDP under the local Government Division ministry of LGRD & C) we discussed it with CWW and revised the budget for the programme and arranged a National Level Consultation on “Challenges and Opportunities of Urban Primary Health Care Services meeting on 14 November 2023 at 10:30 am at PIB conference room, Press Institute of Bangladesh (PIB), 3 circuit house road, Dhaka.

Objectives:

- To know the urban primary health care service delivery system and ensure the access to health care services of urban extreme poor.
- To know about the present situation, challenges and opportunities of UPHCSDP and discussion about the way forward for future sustainability of primary health care services of urban areas

Details Discussion:

In the National consultation programme the **chief guest** was **A.F.M Alauddin Khan**(Additional Secretary,Project Director, Urban Primary Health Care Services Delivery Project-2nd Phase (UPHCSDP-II), Local Government Division, Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development & Co-operatives, the **Special guest** were Manish Kumar Agrawal, Country Director, Concern Worldwide Bangladesh, Md. Abdul Khaled representative of PIB.

The key presenter was Dr. Sharmin Mizan, Deputy Project Director (Service Delivery), UPHCSDP for *brief sharing on the key challenges and opportunities of the Urban Primary health care Service Delivery Project*, The presenter was Dr. Mahmudul Hasan Health Nutrition Advisor Concern Worldwide on *the current situation of urban nutrition*.

The Key discussant was Dr. Abu Jamil Faisal, Public health specialist, The discussant were Doctor Sohana Shafique, Project Coordinator and Facilitator, Urban Health Research Group, ICDDR, Mr. Aminur Rasul, Coordinator PHM, Md Nazrul Islam, Chief Executive Officer & Executive Magistrate, Tarabopaurashava, Naraonganj, Dr. Kazi Ayesha, Health Officer, Savar Municipality and Dr. Nishat parveen, Health Officer,DSCC.

Except this in the open session representative of PA partner NGO Shahina Akter Dolly, CBO representative of slum federation leader Hossney ara Begum Rafeza, representative from self-help group Salma akter, from CWW Mohammed Nabinur Rahman gave their valuable opinions.

The session chair and moderator was Dr. Dibalock Singha, Chairperson CUP, and Executive Director, DSK. Total 60 participants from different sectors (from UPHCSDP PA partners & staff representative, focal; person of partner NGO UPHCSDP, representative of others health service providers, researcher, academician, journalist, health activists, GO city & municipality representatives, slum federation & SHG representatives and PIB, CUP & CWW representatives) were present in the consultation meeting.



At the first welcome speech by Khondker Rebeka Sun-Yat, Executive Director, CUP and she shared the objectives of the consultation meeting. She also shared that we have passed 50 years of liberation period and Bangladesh developed so many and we are going to middle country status. But till now Urban health system is not established so urban population especially poor people deprived their health rights. Under the local government from 1995 urban health care system started and under the urban primary health care project the primary health care services was started from 2000 supported by ADB and co financier. But we knew from the project management office that from 2024 this project will be end up. If this project will end up lot of poor people will deprived from health care services. Still now so many urban poor are not getting the access of primary health care services. So we need sustainability for urban primary service delivery system and 100% coverage for all urban poor people including extreme poor in urban areas.

After the welcome speech, Dr. Sharmin Mizan Deputy Project Director of Urban Primary Health Care Service Delivery Project (UPHCSDP) shared the urban primary services delivery system

Details and success of it. From her brief we knew that from every Nagar Matri Sadan 24 hours open and provide COVID 19 Vaccine and preventive vaccine for child and adolescent, Normal and seizure delivery, primary healthcare mother and child care, family planning services, adolescence health under and identify the cervical cancer of women (above 30 years) and primary health care services for all population. She also share word wise primary health care center and primary health care services. After that she share that the challenges & opportunities about the UPHCSDP:

Challenges and limitations of this project like as Dhaka city-

1. Only 57 ward established health care service but 55 wards is out of this service at Dhaka City.
2. UPHCSDP is project based and donor dependent.
3. Till now data based link is not possible.
4. Sustainable fund is not regularly deposit in the project fund.
5. NGOs extra income is not deposit in the project Fund.

Opportunity:

She also shared some opportunities:

1. Total 151 constructed multi stored building established by under this project which is used for health service city and municipalities.
2. Rules for sustainability fund raising system.
3. Budget code initiated for city and municipalities which are for fund allocation possibility.





After the key presentation some important views & opinion from Guest, Discussant & Participant:

1. Doctor Sohana Shafique, Project Coordinator and Facilitator, Urban Health Research Group, ICDDR,B she shared that this is an excellent service and need its sustainability and reduce death rate of urban poor/population, for universal health coverage out of pocket expenditure need to reduce, identify the service to provide and need base service center like as urban poor areas specially slum areas, for avoiding the duplication mapping is most important. She also advice to resilience health system need to start and involve the local government and accountability specially city and municipalities mayor.
2. Md Nazrul Islam, Chief Executive Officer & Executive Magistrate, Tarabopaurashava, Naraonganj raised some important issues and shared their initiative plan for sustainability of Tarabo paurashava for health care.
 - Motivate the mayor for sustainable fund and raising the sustainable fund for health system like as culvert and road budget allocation
 - For health sustainability include the budget code of municipality/city
 - Those are BMDS fund regular they can be entitled for approval for 80% sustainability deposit the fund
 - If 1 core per year budget for health care service then it will be possibility to sustain.



- Collection for CSR fund for ambulance and income generation deposit for sustainable fund
- 3. Dr. Kazi Ayesha, Health officer Savar Pourashava strongly agreed with CEO, Tarabo municipality and she said that if municipality initiate for raising the fund for health Services and sustainability, possible to run the health care services of municipal area. She also said that in this case mayor must be involved.
- 4. On behalf of slum federation Hosney ara Begum Rafeza and SHG Salma akter said that by this project many poor get the services but extreme poor are not getting the services and centers are far away from slum and pavement areas and center setting nearest the poor area.
- 5. The key discussant *Dr. Abu Jamil Faisal*, Public health specialist said that beside primary health care service mental health is more important for slum, pavement people. Revenge and suicide attempt are increasing and data collection needed for working paper preparation for policy advocacy. Present PD of UPHCSDP-2 need to support like AS ALOK CLINIC DATA SYSTEM experience include to this project. He also recommend that not national but involve local consultant and LGI involvement for data collection and Prepare quick data by the help of local slum people and NGO and LGI which will be used for policy advocacy and sustainability of urban primary health care system.
- 6. Except these so many recommendations from the participants like as Mohammed Nabinur Rahman said that for the sustainability of urban primary health care system needed to strong coordination with two ministry, for extreme poor needed to set the target under this project.

The special Guest and as donor representative Mr. Manish Kumar Agrawal, Country Director, Concern Worldwide Bangladesh thanks CUP and UPHCSDP key presenter for this programme and presentation. He raised some important issues like as last 12 years population growth rate Bangladesh is same.

- huge opportunity of public private partnership in Bangladesh
- health budget is problem
- extreme urban poor are not capable to expend in their health service, citizen participation is more important
- Bangladesh health service budget is very low and GDP rate should be minimum 5%

The chief guest Mr. A.F.M Alauddin Khan (Additional Secretary, Project Director (UPHCSDP-2) Firstly thanks to CUP for organizing the meeting and thanks to participants for active participation and their recommendations. He also thanks to Dr. Abu Jamil Faisal, Public Health Specialist for his views and recommendations.

- A) He agreed for National consultant and he expressed with sad that donor come only for TR project they don't think that Bangladesh have not any expert and capable person for technical support.

- B) He also raised that under the city corporation have so many fund items and 20% opportunity for using health services.
- C) Allocation fund for sustainability in revenue sector
- D) Like **Life house model** can be use in city health service
- E) Unnecessary Service menu rate may be slightly increased
- F) orientation the journalist For publicity of service of this project
- G) NGOs continued the service as contribution
- H) ADB will be initiated for more continuation



He also stated that "It is clearly stated in the DPP of the project that after the completion of the project, the City Corporation and the municipality will continue the program with responsibility. Even if the project ends, the activities will not end. We have an opportunity to do more to improve the quality of service in urban health centers

Lastly as a chair of the consultation meeting Dr. Dibalok Singh gave short summery of the consultation meeting and thanks to Sharmin Mizan for sharing the huge performance opportunities and challenges and he also said that for the universal health and achieve the target of sustainable development goal-3 without intervention of health service of urban poor is not possible. So urban primary health care service delivery needed to continue and sustainability of urban primary health care system. CUP can help for sustainability services through policy advocacy with the involvement health of expert and different stake holders. He also thanks for all participants

Outcome/Way forward:

1. Total 60 active participant from different sector actively participated in the consultation session and representative of extreme urban poor raised their voice

2. Activists and expert are support for working paper preparation and policy advocacy for sustainability of UPHCSDP
3. Some good experience and recommendations come from this meeting which are needed for future advocacy.
4. Minimum 2 newspapers published about the consultation meeting issues.

Programme: 4.5 Orientation and reform BOSC central committee and by including potential extreme urban poor leaders to raise their voices for safe drinking water

Under this programme several activities performed by CUP jointly with central committee.

Activity: 1 Meeting with city (DSCC, DNCC) & central leaders (small group) for discussion of BOSC election

CUP arranged a meeting on 25.10.2023 at 3 pm at CUP office for discussion about the election of BOSC 2023 for reformation of BOSC central committee and also discussion about the selection of election commissioner tofshil of election. The president of south Harun Ar Rashid and south president Meherun nessa sheuly and president of central committee Hosneyara Begum Rafeza and others two leaders were present in the meeting



Decision:

1. As per constitution of BOSC Three election commissioner were selected 1 is our vice president of CUP Mr. Mabbubul Haque as chief election commissioner , 2 Mr. Aminur Rasul, coordinator PHM, election commissioner and Shimanto Shiraz member of Management committee human rights development center as election commissioner
2. Possible date was set up on 30.11.2023 before that tofshil will be prepared with the help of election commissioner and circulated to the voter with the help of CBO leaders

3. Election commissioner secretariat set up at CUP BOSC office CUP ED will be responsible for member secretary of election commission and support to election commissioner for

Activity: 2: Appointment of election commissioners and Work with election commissioners for election schedule/tofshil preparation and election activities for BOSC reformation

As per member secretary CUP ED meeting with election commission members and time to time support for election of BOSC reformation 2024-2026.

1. Prepared the tofshil on 27.10.2023 and sharing with core BOSC and SHG leaders
2. Prepared the voter list with the help of city and central president of BOSC
3. Prepared nomination paper and vote box for election
4. Nomination paper supply and receive the nomination paper/panel
5. Select the final candidate and prepared the list and declaration

Activity: 3: Orientation on election programme with core leaders, central committee and voter of North south city corporation

On behalf of election commissioner member secretary and CUP ED, programme person of CUP arrange discussion and orientation session about BOSC election and procedure with the help of BOSC.

1. On 11.11.2023 preparatory meeting with BOSC and central committee members and SHG leaders for preparation of the election for reformation of BOSC and voter selection at CUP office at 11 am.



2. On 18.11.2023 meeting BOSC city committee members and voters selective local SHG leaders for orientation and voter selection for BOSC reformation 2024-2026 at Ta block, world vision office Mirpur DNCC at 11 am.



3. On 19.11.2023 meeting BOSC city committee members and voters selective local SHG leaders for orientation and voter selection for BOSC reformation 2024-2026 at Haraibag, DSCC at 2 pm.



4. On 22.11.2023 meeting with representative of BOSC central committee members SHG for finalize the voter list and center for election at 4 pm at CUP office



5. On 26.11.2023 meeting with selective leaders and representative of election commissioner for nomination paper/panel list submission and received for BOSC election at 4 pm CUP office.



Outcome

1. More than hundred CBO leaders oriented and participated in the different meeting and aware about the democratic meeting
2. 50 final voter were selected from DSCC, DNCC, Tanggi municipality, Chatrogram city corporation, Sylhet city corporation, Bogura municipality, Faridpur municipalities.

3. Out of 50 more than 10 voter selected from SHG leaders.
4. 23 panel list are submitted jointly with BOSC and CBO,SHG leaders

Activities: 4 Orientation on extreme urban poor and their rights and election for BOSC reformation

On 30 November 2023 CUP and BOSC jointly arrange an orientation session on extreme urban poor and their rights at first session and second session election and reformation of BOSC central committee at west dhamondi, Riverview housing, greater hazaribag, ward 14, DSCC at 10:30 am to 1 pm.



First session was conducted CUP ED Khondker Rebeka Sun-Yat and find out the extreme urban poor people of urban areas through participatory discussion and views of activist and expert. The chief guest was present renewed labour leader and trade union expert Mr. Abul Hossain and as discussant were Mr. Helal Uddin, programme officer, Bangladesh Nari Progati Sangha and Mr. Ferdous Ahmed ujjal, Programme coordinator BARCIK, Nigar Rahman, Programme coordinator Insight Bangladesh.

Outcome:

1. More than 70 Participants were present in the meeting and grass root leaders of BOSC and SHG leaders strongly raised their voice and opinion about the issues
2. The grass root participants were known about the extreme urban poor in their urban communities
3. Find out the extreme urban poor` those people are not able to fulfill their daily needs, **“shelter less and informal vulnerable shelter and minimum income and maximum dependency”**



Second Session: BOSC election 2023

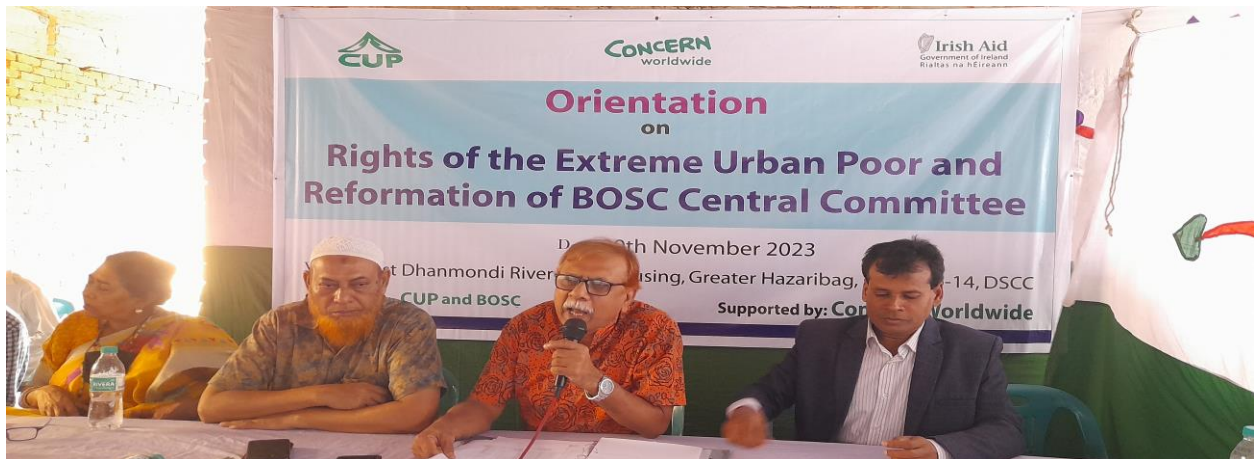
The first session and health/social break the election commissioner taking the sit and president of central committee extinguished the central committee and request to election commissioners to conduct the election and reformation of BOSC.

Three election commissioner Mr. Mahbulul Haque, Chief election commissioner & Vice-Chairperson, CUP, Mr. Aminur Rasul Election Commissioner & Co-coordinator, Shimanto Shiraz election commissioner and Khondker Rebeka Sun-Yat present as member secretary of election commission. At first the chief election commissioner gave his opinion and request one of the election commissioner Mr. Aminur Rasul to share the election procedure and present status. He said that all procedure of election they are complete including voter box and he shared activities of election commission to fulfill. He also expressed that we are very much happy for without any bad situation we complete the election process. We received one panel of 23 persons. In this panel 5 from representatives of other cities and 18 from DSCC & DNCC candidates. No other nomination paper or panel submission not submitted in any voter in the time.



After that the chief election commissioner request to other election commission Mr. Shimanto Shiraz for sharing the panel list of candidates and he also request to the participants any

Arguments or questions about the election. Mr. Shimanto Shiraz shared the submitted panel list of BOSC central committee and thanks to CUP secretariat for supporting the election and BOSC and SHG leaders for submitting the panel with the consent of others voter members. All participant agreed and welcome the panel.





After that the chief election commissioner declared the list as final committee of BOSC for 2024-2026 and thanks to all voters' organizers and CUP secretariat.

Outcome:

1. A good committee reformation of BOSC for next 3 years from 2024-2026 without any conflict
2. More than 5 persons of SHG leaders are selected as central committee members of BOSC some are achieved the portfolio post.
3. All voters of central committee election of BOSC including SHG members sensitize and aware about central election and committee formation of BOSC
